Dear Parent/Carers,

This year, our whole school focus once again is promoting positive relationships. During this term's parents evening, we want to ensure that we make those initial connections and relationships so will be focussing on getting to know you and your child.

From feedback, we were made aware that it would be helpful for you to know what the topics of discussion will be so that you can give it some thought in advance.

Here are some possible questions we might ask you:

Is there anything you can tell me about your child that you think would help me support his/her learning?

What are their interests and do they take part in any out-of-school clubs?

What does your child most worry about?

Is there anything else you want me to know?

We are also incredibly lucky this year that a member of the Mental Health Support Team will be available for short drop-in chats on Monday and Wednesday between 4 and 5 pm. They will be able to offer support and guidance around managing your child's mental health.

Parents evenings for both Langstone Junior and Langstone Infant Academies will take place the week beginning 9th October 2023.

The slots will be 10 mins each and all meetings will take place in person as it is the best way to build positive relationships. **In order to have honest and open discussions, we ask that children do NOT accompany parents this time.** We advise that if you have more than one child and want to synchronise your appointments, you book early when the bookings open on your Parentmail App at **8pm on Monday, 25th of September.**
