Homework Expectations

At Langstone, we will be providing homework as an opportunity to extend and support your child's learning. It also provides opportunities for parents and pupils to work in partnership and enjoy learning experiences together.

Whilst homework is set to prepare them for the upcoming learning and consolidate skills already taught, we also seek to teach valuable organisation skills in preparation for secondary school where we know pupils are required to complete a wide range of work independently at home. We have seen some fantastic improvements from pupils, in all areas, over the previous years and we want to encourage our pupils to continue this in the future.

What form will homework take?

Homework can include:

- Maths related tasks based on learning including weekly arithmetic practice
- Times Tables Rock Stars sessions
- Punctuation and grammar work to support English learning
- Daily reading
- Spelling – exception words will have a half termly focus to master some of these trickier words
- Project based for children to decide on content and presentation (Optional)

Occasionally, homework will be set using Google Classroom to further develop the children's skills and use of a blended classroom model.

Children will be provided with enough time each week to allow them to complete their homework tasks at home. If homework is not completed at home, they will be asked to join homework club at break or lunchtime to give them the opportunity to complete the same learning as their peers.
