## Year 5 To SeaCity Museum

Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our 'Sailing the Waves' theme for the Spring term, we are planning a trip to The Sea City Museum in Southampton which is based around the Titanic. The trip is designed to enthuse and enhance the children's learning and understanding of nautical history. Whilst at the museum, the children will take part in 'Discovery Sessions' which are informative, engaging and interactive guided tours. The children will follow the stories of the crew who lived and worked on board RMS Titanic.

The cost of the trips will be **£8.93 per child which can be paid on Scopay**. The cost will include entrance fees into the Museum, a guided tour, workshop and the cost of fuel.

### How to pay and consent online

- Complete the online form via Scopay for the trip
- Consent
- Checkout and Pay

Each Year 5 class will travel on a different day by minibus to ensure that the price of the trip is as low as possible. The dates for the trips are as follows:

5EJ - Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> February 2024

5DS - Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2024

On the day of this trip, the children will be expected to wear school uniform and bring a packed lunch with them. If you would like your child to be provided with a school packed lunch, please indicate this on the Scopay Form. Whilst there is a gift shop at the museum, we will not be visiting during our trip. Therefore, we ask that you do not send your child into school with any money.

We are all really excited about this and hope that the children will be too. We would appreciate payment and consent submitted on Scopay by Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> February 2024.
