Our class will be visiting the Jami Mosque to gain first-hand experience and knowledge about Islamic religious practices. This outing aligns with our recent lessons on rituals, during which the children delved into the concept of 'wudu' and its significance in Islam. An understanding of these rituals in real-life will foster a deeper appreciation of the various cultures and diversity within our school community.

The visit to the mosque provides a unique opportunity for our students to observe and learn about religious practices in a respectful and inclusive environment. They will have the chance to witness the significance of 'wudu' and understand its role in daily Islamic life. Our aim is to foster a sense of cultural awareness, tolerance, and respect for diversity among our students.

Moreover, this trip serves as a bridge to our upcoming unit, where we will explore the symbolism of flight in different religions. The connection between our previous learning about rituals and the symbolism of flight will be highlighted during this visit. Students will have the chance to inquire about the symbolic elements present in the mosque architecture and Islamic art, which will lay the foundation for our next unit of study.
